Gabriella Miller Kids First Research Act 2.0 This bill would modify funding for a pediatric disease research initiative within the National Institutes of Health (NIH). Currently, this initiative receives funding through FY 2023 from the 10-Year Pediatric Research Initiative Fund. This bill directs certain penalties assessed by the Securities and Exchange Commission against pharmaceutical companies for specified violations to that fund. In making allocations from the fund, the NIH must prioritize pediatric research that does not duplicate existing research activities.	H.R.3392 Rep.
